FAIRFAX FINANCIAL HOLDINGS LIMITED ENTRANCE AWARD

The Sixty Three Foundation established two (2) entrance awards to assist students entering the first year of a full-time diploma or undergraduate degree program at Douglas College. The objective of the awards is to assist worthy candidates for whom the cost of pursuing a post-secondary education would be a serious impediment.

Value: \$3,500 each academic year, payable directly towards tuition.

The award may be renewed for the duration of the full-time program.

Application Deadline: Apply by April 1, 2014

Eligibility:

The minimum requirements for the Fairfax Financial Holdings Limited Entrance Award are:

- 1) Financial need (to be determined by the Financial Aid Office);
- 2) Be a Canadian citizen or have been granted permanent residence in Canada;
- 3) Have been accepted into (and must ultimately attend) the first year of a full time diploma or undergraduate degree program with a scheduled duration not longer than four years. A minimum 80% course load is required;
- 4) Have achieved a cumulative average of at least 75% in the recipient's graduating year (which must have terminated not later than 18 months prior to the beginning of the academic year) at a Canadian secondary school or CEGEP; and
- 5) Not have previously received a Fairfax award.

Selection Criteria:

The selection of a recipient from among all eligible applicants will be primarily on the basis of the greatness of need, but the following could also be influential:

- 1) Outstanding academic achievement, or independently documented outstanding achievement, or
- 2) Commitment in community or other extracurricular activities.

Eligibility for Renewal:

Each recipient of an initial reward or a subsequent award will be entitled to a subsequent award for an additional academic year if the recipient:

- 1) Continues to demonstrate financial need;
- Intends to (and ultimately does) continue full-time in the diploma or undergraduate degree program initially commenced and has not yet earned a diploma or degree therein. A minimum 80 percent course load is required;
- 3) Has passed, and achieved an average of at least 3.0 in each previous academic year of the program; and
- 4) Was in full time attendance in the program during the immediately preceding academic year in a minimum 80 percent course load.
