## MAJOR ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

### The President's Scholarship (\$20,000)

#### ELIGIBILITY

- » Enrolling at KPU in a **four year program**
- » 80% average in English 12 and three other academic Grade 12 courses, or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits
- » Demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

#### CONDITIONS

- » Registration in a **minimum of 12 undergraduate credits** per semester
- » Required to maintain a **minimum CGPA of 3.0** for the duration of the awards period

#### VALUE & QUANTITY

**Fall Semester Intake** » Four awards;  
\$5,000 per year for up to four years

**Spring Semester Intake** » Two awards;  
\$5,000 per year for up to four years (September deadline)

### The Merit Scholarship (\$5,000)

#### ELIGIBILITY

- » Enrolling in **any** KPU program
- » 80% average in English 12 and three other academic Grade 12 courses, or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits
- » Demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

#### VALUE & QUANTITY

**Fall Semester Intake** » Twelve awards;  
\$5,000 split over two terms in first year

**Spring Semester Intake** » Six awards;  
\$5,000 split over two terms in first year  
(September deadline)

#### CONDITIONS

- » Registration in a **minimum of 12 undergraduate credits** per semester
- » Required to maintain a **minimum CGPA of 3.0** for the duration of the awards period

### The Indigenous Entrance Scholarship (\$5,000)

#### ELIGIBILITY

- » Must identify as Aboriginal, First Nations, Metis or Inuit
- » 80% average in English 12 and three other academic Grade 12 courses, or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits
- » Demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

#### VALUE & QUANTITY

**Fall Semester Intake** » 12 awards;  
\$5,000 split over 2 terms in first year

**Spring Semester Intake** » 6 awards;  
\$5,000 split over 2 terms in first year  
(September deadline)

#### CONDITIONS

- » Registration in a **minimum of 12 undergraduate credits** per semester
- » Required to maintain a **minimum CGPA of 3.0** for the duration of the awards period

# DONOR-FUNDED ENTRANCE AWARDS

## (\$1,000 - \$4,000)

### ELIGIBILITY

- » Based upon specific requirements (eg. essay submission, school district, financial need). Students will be considered for donor-funded awards if they provide the required specific supporting documentation stated for each award.

### VALUE & QUANTITY

**Fall Semester Intake** » Various awards; paid as tuition credit in Fall term



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Entrance Award applicants will be short-listed and ranked by the Scholarships & Awards Selection Committee, based on the criteria for each award.

Award payment is subject to admission and confirmation of enrolment (minimum 12 credits per semester) and final marks of eligible candidates, prior to the disbursement of the award.

Major Entrance Scholarship payments will be divided between the September and January semesters, and applied to any outstanding tuition and fees first (subject to continuance requirements). Any remaining balance will be made available to the award recipient in the form of a cheque.

All Entrance Award recipients are eligible to apply for other scholarships, awards and bursaries for which they meet the criteria.

Only one online application is required in order to be considered for any of the awards.
