Education - What do I need?

- A bachelor's degree (4 years), common areas of study are kinesiology, sport science, health science or psychology
- Most people will have to have work experience before being admitted into a two year Masters of Physical Therapy program
- In high school, Pre-Calculus 12, Anatomy & Physiology 12 are required but each university has other required courses as well (check their admissions website)
- you can take PE and Health Exercise Science 12 as electives
